The Glens Falls Home, Inc. is pleased to announce the appointment of Frank Mezzano as its new executive director. Mr. Mezzano comes to the Glens Falls Home with a background in private business as well as local, county, and state government.

The Mezzano family founded the Speculator Department Store in Speculator, NY, in 1949. Mr. Mezzano and his wife Bette eventually purchased the business from family members and ran it for many years, until selling it in 1999.

Mr. Mezzano was elected Supervisor of the Town of Lake Pleasant in 1993 and remained in office until 2010. As a member of the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors, he served as Chairman of Finance as well as County Budget Officer. He also represented Hamilton County on various Adirondack boards and committees, including the Adirondack Park Local Government Review Board and the Adirondack Association of Towns and Villages. In 1998 he was appointed as an Adirondack Park Agency Commissioner by Governor Pataki and continues in that capacity today.

The Glens Falls Home, Inc. was incorporated in 1898 to provide residential services for aging women, and for over 100 years operated a residence of aged women on Warren Street in the City of Glens Falls. The residence was closed in 2001, and the building was sold. Since that time The Glens Falls Home, Inc. has been creating opportunities for seniors in the community by partnering in the development and operation of “The Glen at Hiland Meadows” community in Queensbury, as well as the “Homeward Bound” program of Hudson Headwaters Health Network.
